Jim Franz Community Service Lifetime Achievement

Award recognizes extraordinary, long-time commitment and service to the community of Alameda over a period of 25 or more years.

Community Service Volunteer of the year Award

recognizes extraordinary service to the community of Alameda over a period of 10 or more years.

Community Service Award – Individual recognizes acts that involve any activity that made a difference for the Alameda community.

Community Service Award – Non-Profit Organization

recognizes an outstanding non-profit that has made Alameda a better place to live over a period of 3 years or more.

Community Service Award – Non-Profit Board Member

recognizes service on the Board of an Alameda non-profit for at least 2 years.

Community Service Award – Youth recognizes the outstanding commitment and contributions made by youth to their community. Two Awards will be given.

Community Service Award – Business and Business

Person recognizes the outstanding contributions by a business and an business person in Alameda in support of critical social services (youth, food security, health and wellbeing, employment training, etc.). One award for a Business and one award for a Business Person will be given.
