Kindergartners will pay the same amount as the 1ST to 5TH Graders since ARPD will pick them up just prior to the 1ST to 5TH Grade dismissal time.


All new and returning participants will be eligible to register. In order for your child to be picked up on the first day of RAP, your child must be registered by **WEDNESDAY**, **AUGUST 16th.**

IF YOUR CHILD'S RAP SITE IS FULL, ADD YOUR CHILD'S NAME TO THE WAITING LIST. WE MAY BE ABLE TO OPEN UP ADDITIONAL SPACES AS WE GET CLOSER TO THE START OF THE SCHOOL YEAR.





In order to continue your RAP enrollment for the remainder of the school year, you will need to renew your child's registration online. You will notified by email and given a limited time period when the 2024 Winter & Spring Sessions are open for renewals. You will only be able to register online if your child is enrolled in the previous session. For these two sessions, you will have the choice to pay the Single Payment or pay two Auto-Payments. If a site has availability and you were not registered for the previous session, please contact ARPD.

IMPORTANT:

Before RAP Program can begin at a school site, we must have 8 students registered. If we do not meet our minimum number, there is a possibility that our RAP Program for that school may be delayed or cancelled.

WHERE DO WE MEET OUR RAP LEADERS?

Meet your RAP Leaders at the pre-designated pick-up areas at the school (see list below). All participants will walk back to the park as a group with the RAP Leaders. Once RAP Staff leaves school grounds for their park site, they cannot return to school for late kids (i.e. field trips, enrichment, etc.).

Any kids with bikes, scooters, skateboards or roller blades **MUST walk or carry** them and obey all traffic laws on the way to the park. Be sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather.

WHEN DOES RAP MEET?

RAP meets every school day at dismissal time, including modified or early dismissal school days and ends at 5:30 p.m.

THERE IS NO RAP CARE ON SCHOOL HOLIDAYS OR NON-SCHOOL DAYS. AUSD provides us with the early and modified day schedule before the year begins and we plan accordingly. RAP fees **DO NOT** cover cost or enrollment for any non-school vacation camps. (Camp enrollments require separate forms and fees).

Safety is of the utmost importance for all ARPD participants. Providing ARPD with this information is necessary so that we may determine if and how we can safely support your child.

FEE SCHEDULE FOR 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR — AUGUST 21, 2023 TO JUNE 6, 2024

All fees must be paid a minimum of 48 business hours in advance before your child is picked up for RAP. You must pay by the published due dates.

If your child is not listed on our roster at the start of a RAP session, RAP Staff will walk your child to the school office and leave them there if they cannot reach parent/guardian.

ATTENTION ALL 3-DAY PARTICIPANTS:

DAY CHANGES - You must specify the days of the week your child will attend. These days will remain the same for the full session unless you pay the \$15 administrative fee to change them.

EXTRA DAYS— You **CANNOT** swap any unused regular day(s) for any extra day(s). You may add a one-time additional pick up day (outside of your regular days); there is a \$21 per day charge which must be paid in full 48 business hours in advance of the date needed.

RECEIPTS - You can access all your payment transactions and receipts through your online account. The Official 2023 Tax Receipt can be printed from your online account after January 1, 2024.

LATE PICK UPS

All participants must be picked up by 5:30 p.m. Starting at 5:31 p.m., a late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged for late pick-ups payable that day.

If you are more than 30 minutes late, we will contact the Alameda Police Department to pick up your child and take him/her to the Police Department. If late pick ups are a consistent problem, we will take further appropriate action.

NEED FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE?

A limited number of partial scholarships are available for Alameda residents only. To apply, you will need to complete a Fee Assistance Request Form.
