- New turn arrows

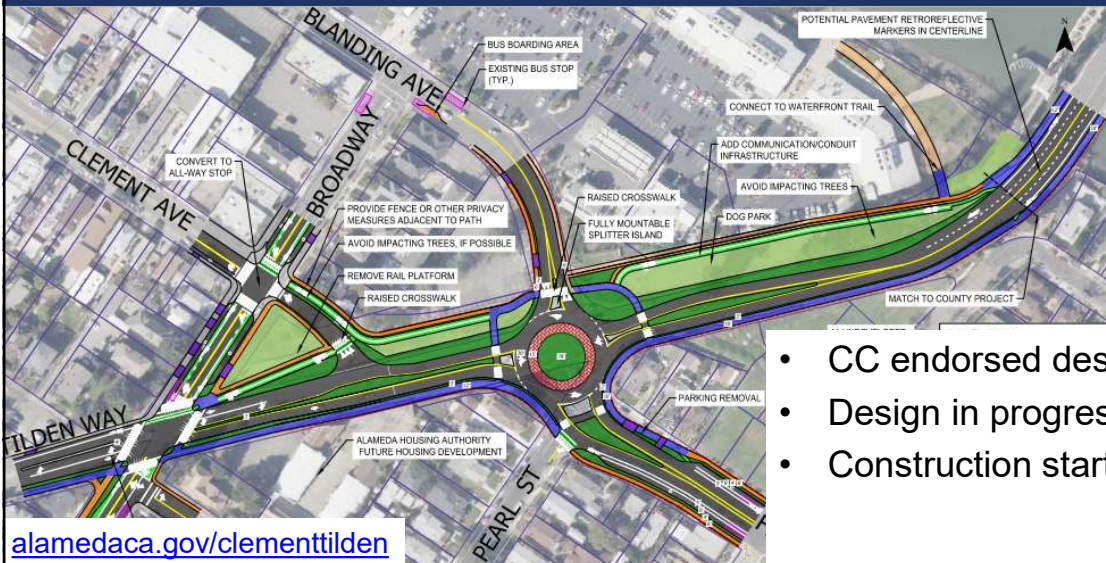

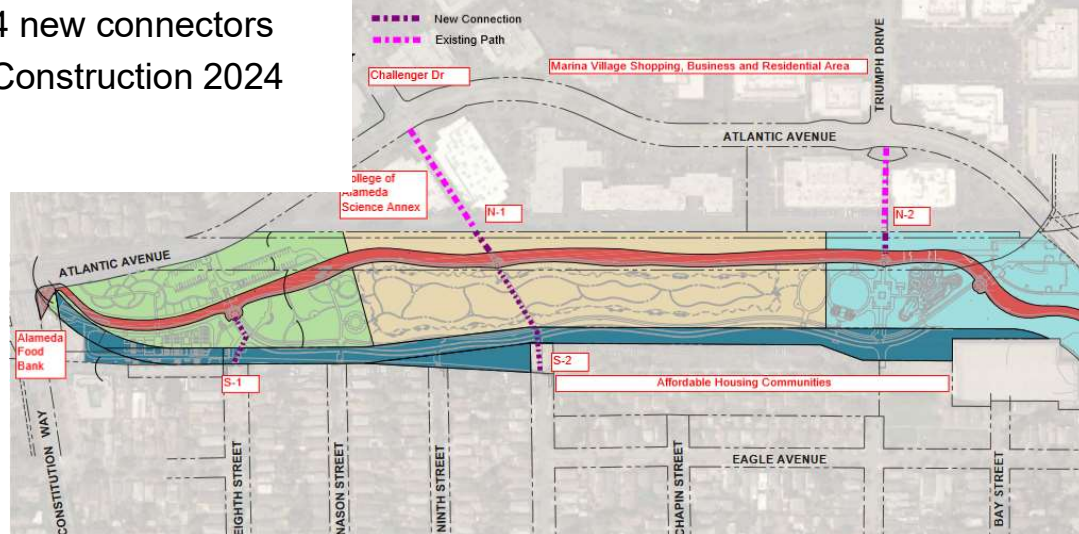

- Construction 2024



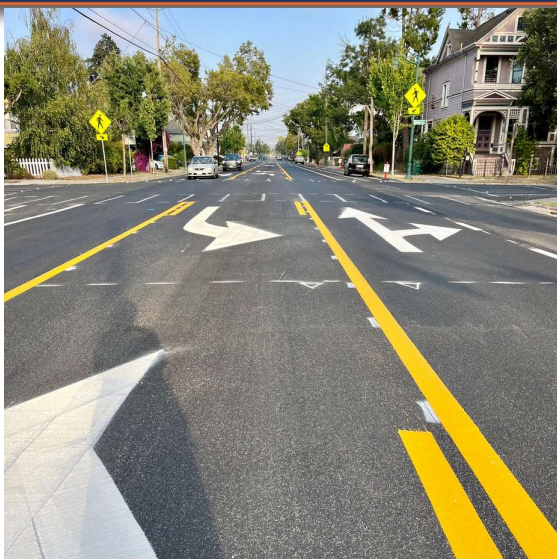
Alameda Point Adaptive Reuse

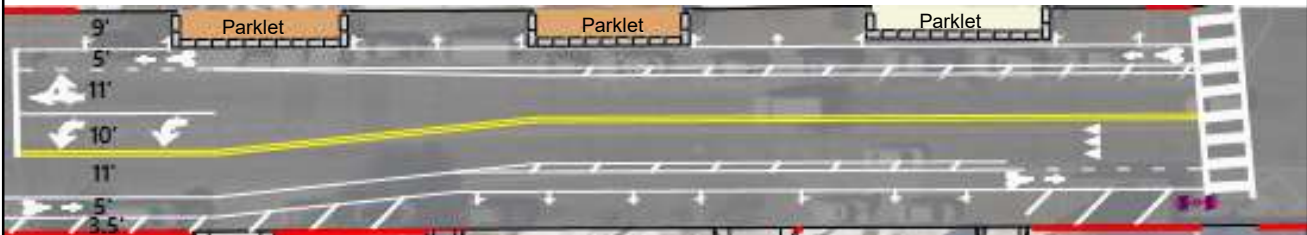

 - Bio-retention areas at the three funded roundabouts

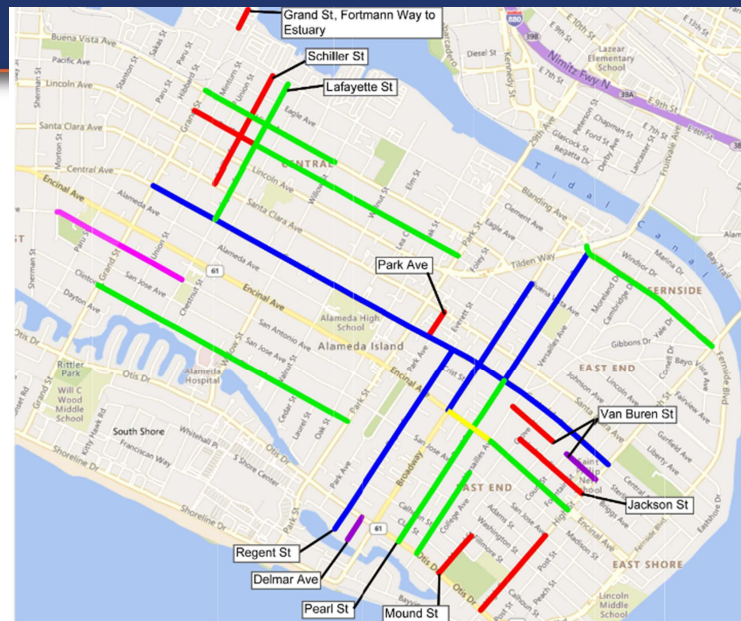

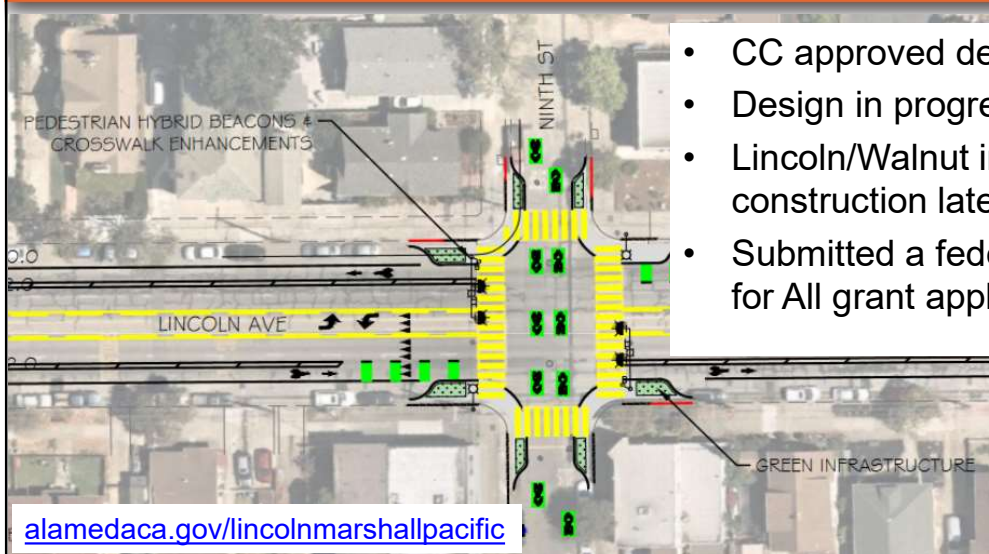

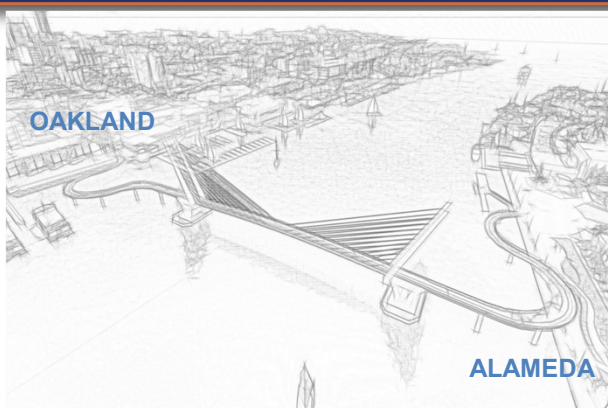

Oakland-Alameda Estuary Bridge



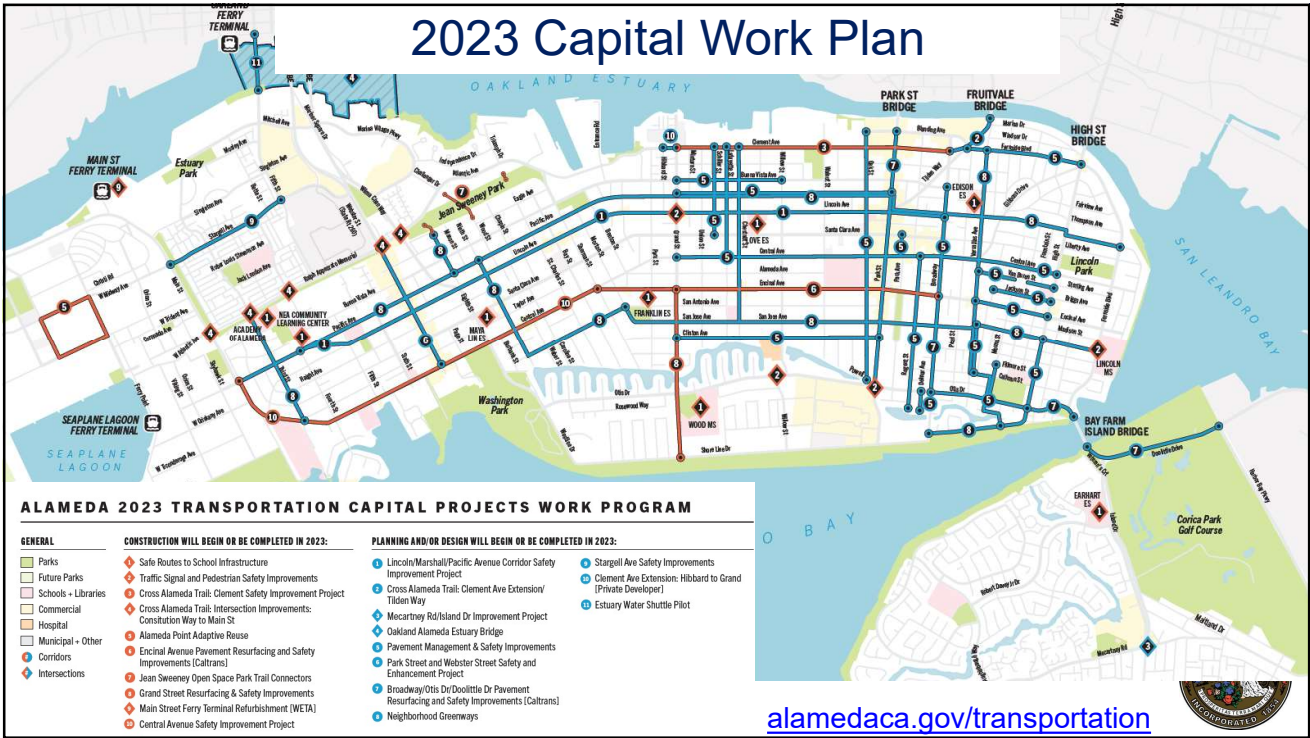
CONCEPTUAL SKETCH for Washington to Fifth St alternative
