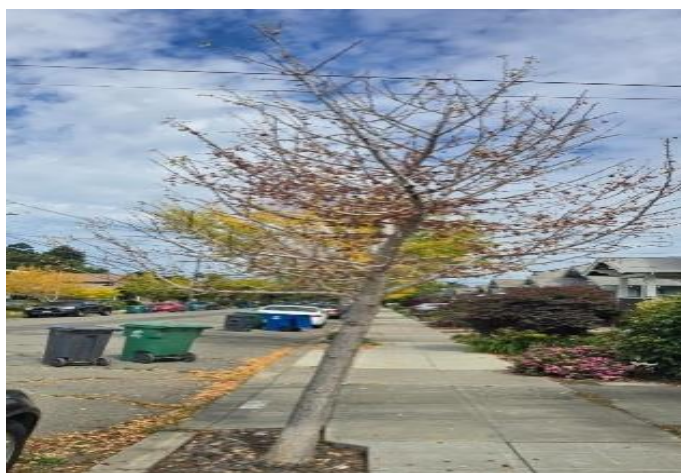

Summary: The tree at 3261 Liberty Avenue is in decline. The tree has significant decay as well as deterioration of the root system. There are no practical or reasonable options to mitigate the decline which will ultimately cause the tree to die, therefore removal is recommended.
