 - j. Portable charger for phone
 - k. Sturdy shoes
 - I. Cold weather and rain gear
 - m. Shovel
 - n. Toilet paper
 - o. Any items specific to the needs of your family
 - i. Medicine
 - ii. Glasses and/or contact lens supplies
 - iii. Items for babies (such as formula, diapers, and wipes)
