


## 2022 HOMELESS POINT-IN-TIME COUNT & SURVEY

Every two years communities across the country conduct comprehensive counts of people experiencing homelessness in order to measure the prevalence and characteristics of homelessness. The 2022 Alameda County EveryOne Home Point-in-Time Count which included a detailed assessment of the city of Alameda, was a community-wide effort conducted on February 23rd, 2022. In the weeks following the street count, a survey was administered in the city of Alameda to 91 unsheltered and sheltered homeless persons in order to better understand their experiences and help assess their needs.
