




Alameda Carnegie Building

- Built in 1902
- Operated as a library until 1998
- National Register of Historic Place



Request for Qualifications (RFQ)

- Released in October 2018
- Objectives
 - Provide community benefits
 - Restore & maintain historic character
 - Provide for public use
 - Demonstrate financial resources
- Estimated \$6 million in restoration
