Project Goals:

Build a new City aquatic center at the site of the existing Emma Hood Swim Center, on budget and to LEED Certification

Budget:


Approximately \$15MM Construction Budget

Project Steps Timeline:

- 1. Community Process (Q1, 2020)**
- 2. Concept Design (Q1, 2020)**
- 3. Concept Approval (Q2, 2020)**
- 4. Confirm Funding (Q4, 2020) Source (Example: Infrastructure Bond–Nov. 2020)**
- 5. If approved by Voters Grand opening occurs 2 years following confirmation of funding resource.**
