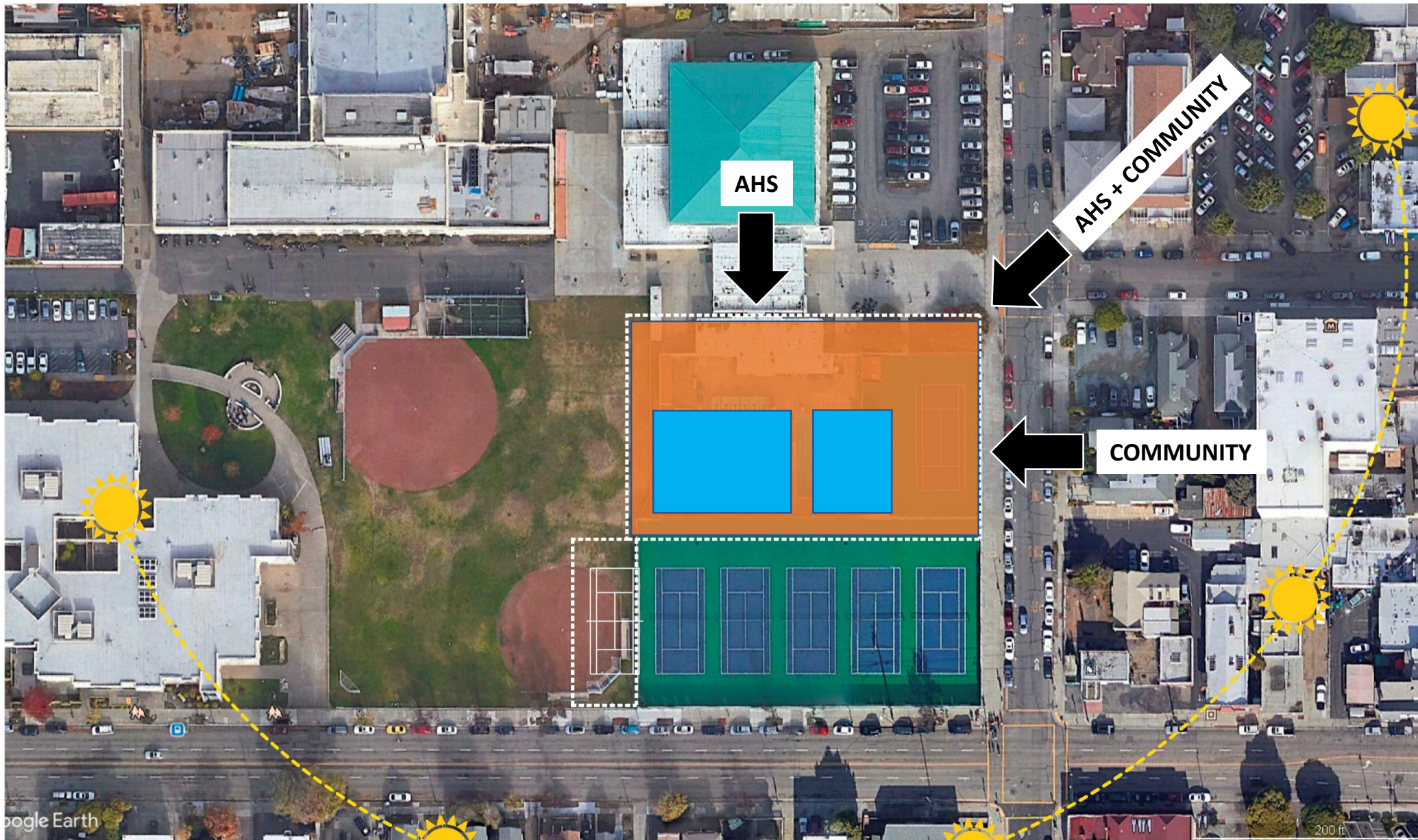

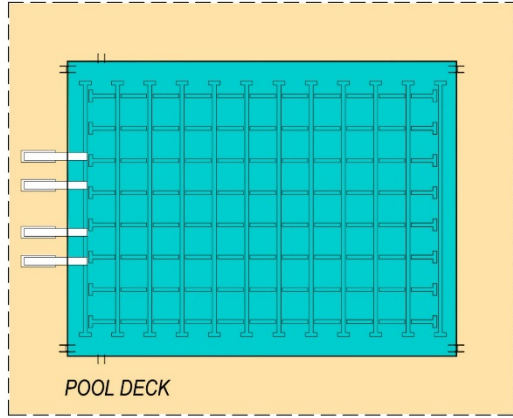




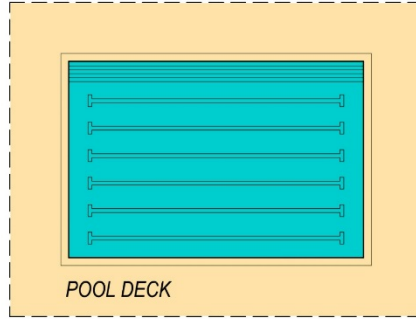
ALAMEDA CITY AQUATICS CENTER SITE



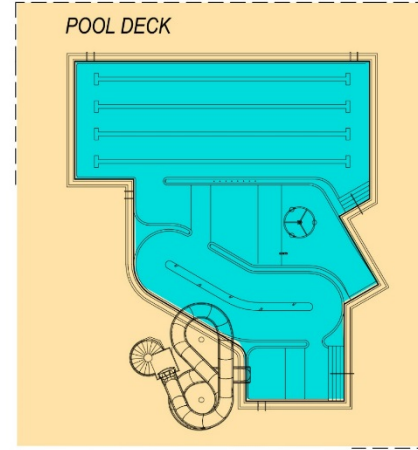
