
Follow the Paden Elementary School Traffic Pattern



NOTE:

- Starting October 2025, there will be protected bike lanes along the south side of Central Avenue, in front of Paden Elementary School
- When possible, walk, bike, or park along a designated street and use the walking route to get to school
- When entering/exiting the drop-off area, do not block the bike lanes and pull as far forward as you can in the drop off lane
- Be alert for pedestrians and bicyclists

There is active construction on Central Avenue between Pacific and 5th Street. Traffic patterns are subject to change. Use caution, follow signs and flaggers, and check the **Central Avenue Safety Project** website (alamedaca.gov/central) for up to date information.
