

# CURB EXTENSIONS




### **DEFINITION**

» Extension of the sidewalk into the street at intersections or mid-block

#### **BENEFITS**

- » Reduces crossing distance for pedestrians
- » Increases visibility for pedestrians, bicyclists, and
- » Slows turning vehicles

# SPEED HUMPS



## **DEFINITION**

» Raised areas of pavement surface placed across roadway

#### **BENEFITS**

» Lowers vehicle speeds

# TRAFFIC CIRCLE



## **DEFINITION**

» Raised circular median placed in intersection on neighborhood streets

»Existing stop signs removed, and replaced with Yield signs, so approaching traffic yields to circulating traffic

#### **BENEFITS**

» Lowers vehicle speeds » Reduces right-angle crashes





## **DEFINITION**

- » User-actuated yellow flashing lights that alert drivers to yield where bicyclists and pedestrians have the right-of-way crossing a road » Includes high-visibility
- crosswalks

#### **BENEFITS**

» Can increase driver yield behavior when paired with standard crossing warning signs and markings
