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## Summary

Due to COVID-19, per City Manager, there will be no increases to the Master Fee Schedule for FY 20/21. Fees may be re-evaluated in the fall depending on the state of the economy. Exceptions are the Recreation & Park fee schedule which was approved by Council November 2019 and DIF fees approved July 2019. Rent Program fees were approved by Council in June 2020.

## Changes other than CPI:

Recreation and Park Fees were adopted by the City Council on November 29, 2019.

The Rent Stabilization Program fee was adopted by the City Council by Resolution # 153888 on June 5, 2018 and is effective July 1, 2018. FY 2020/21 Rent program fees were adopted June 16, 2020.

Planning & Building Department Fees for the Historic Preservation category for Certificate of Approval by Staff - Tree Removal was incorrect in the Master Fee Schedule for FY 2019/20. It has been corrected for FY 2020/21 and a line item for Certificate of Approval by Staff - Dead/Diseased Tree Removal has been added.

Development Impact Fees (DIF) were adopted by the City Council on July 16, 2019.






