









Next Steps

- Refine Options early 2019
 - Transportation Commission: January 23
 - City Council: February 19
- Analyze Options early/mid 2019
- Request Concept Approval for Webster Street Area – mid 2019
- Final Design 2020/2021
- Construction 2021





Central Ave Safety Project

- Safety Project: Pedestrians, Bicyclists, Automobiles
- Collisions = Injuries or Death
- Reduce speeding, reduce likelihood of collisions, reduce severity of injury
- Make corridor more pleasant to live on and travel on. More fun, less dangerous
- Reduce reliance on automobile
- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions






Safety

- 89 injuries from collisions past 10 years
 - 18 walking = 20% (16% citywide)
 - 22 bicycling = 25% (16% citywide)
- Bicycling/walking injuries = 45% (32% citywide)
- Study Area mileage = 1.4% of citywide streets
- Study Area injuries = 4.1% (compared to citywide injuries)
- Actual Speeds: 30-33 mph
 - 25% Average Risk of Death at 32.5 mph
 - 10% Average Risk of Death at 24.1 mph







Safety: Three-lane Streets

According to FHWA:

- Reduces collisions by at least 19%
- Reduces speeds by at least 3 mph
- Less severe collisions
- Fewer vehicle lanes to cross
- Better visibility of pedestrians
- Space for bicyclists
- Smoother travel flow





Work to Date

- West End Section
 - Two-way Protected Bikeway
- East End Section
 - Bike Lanes (except for Webster Street Area)



Approved Concept: West End

- Two-way Protected Bikeway:
 - Alameda Point
 - Paden, Encinal and Junior Jets Schools
 - SF Bay Trail





Approved Concept: Paden School-Sherman (except for the Webster Street Area)

Do nothing different

Two-way separated bikeway

Sharrow markings

- One-way separated bikeway
- Bike lanes + center turn lane Buffered bike lanes



Design Options

(Paden Elementary to Washington Park)

- No Build Alternative (Existing Conditions)
- Webster Street to Washington Park
 - Bike Lanes and Sharrows at Webster Street
 - Continuous Bike Lanes
 - Two-way Protected Bikeway
- Paden Elementary to McKay/Bay Trail
 - Bike Lanes
 - Two-way Protected Bikeway






General Improvements

- Bicycle Lanes, Two-way Protected Bikeway, and Bike Racks
- Curb Bulbs, Enhanced Crosswalks, Pedestrian Refuges, and Pedestrian Beacons
- Traffic Signals New / Improved
- Street Lighting
- Bus Stop Improvements
- Landscaping, Street Trees, and Green Stormwater Infrastructure
- Accessible On-street Parking















Raised Protected Bikeway Examples





SHARROWS, CLASS II BICYCLE LANES AND TWO-WAY PROTECTED BIKEWAY OPTIONS DECEMBER, 2018













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


