

# ALAMEDA FALLEN FIREFIGHTERS MEMORIAL

Dear Friends,

As you may already be aware, the City of Alameda has built a new Fire Station 3, located on the corner of Buena Vista Avenue and Hibbard Street. This new firehouse provides first due Fire, Rescue and Emergency Medical Service to Central Alameda. It replaces the historic old firehouse on the corner of Pacific Avenue and Grand Street that was found to be seismically unsafe over a decade ago. Essential to emergency services and rich with history, Fire Station 3 was completed in the spring of 2017.

The City recently implemented a policy requiring artwork to be included at new facilities. This policy strives to improve the visual appreciation of the property, as well as provide enrichment to the community for many years to come. The approved art plan for Fire Station 3 includes a beautifully landscaped area that will be home to the Alameda Fallen Firefighters Memorial. The memorial will honor the firefighters who have given their lives in the line of duty serving our community, as well as pay homage to the proud history of the City of Alameda and the Alameda Fire Department.

The Department is very proud of the design of the memorial. Visitors are welcomed to the site with an entrance grate that symbolizes the bridges that are so critical to our Island lifestyle and the access hereto. With benches that provide a quiet place for reflection, the bronze sculpture at the center will illustrate the dedication and sacrifice of firefighters who have served our community for over 140 years. A memorial wall will honor the fallen by bearing their names for eternity.

The memorial was designed by Artist and Sculptor Lawrence Noble of Noble Studio in Berkeley, CA. His work can be found throughout the region and across the country. Mr. Noble's work includes the California Firefighters' Memorial located in historic Capitol Park in Sacramento, the Gold Medal for the 1984 Olympic Games, and the famous Yoda Fountain that resides at the Letterman Digital Arts Center located in the Presidio of San Francisco.

The Alameda Fallen Firefighters Memorial is an opportunity for the Fire Department and the community to form a partnership. This partnership can bring us together as stewards of history on the Island, with a commitment towards the future. In order to bring this concept to life, we are seeking financial donors to assist in reaching the project goal of \$200,000.

While any contribution will help, there are several options that will allow donors to become a permanent part of the memorial. Granite pavers (\$550), large granite square pavers (\$4,000), memorial benches (\$20,000), and a bronze plaque (\$10,000) are available to be inscribed with your name, or perhaps the name of a loved one. These will be placed on the site for as long as it stands, as part of the art. Space is limited, so please act fast. *Please note that your contribution will be tax deductible.*

- GRANITE PAVER - \$550**  
*Granite pavers (5" x 9") will be inscribed individually and inlaid around a Maltese cross on the ground of the memorial. Inscriptions will consist of three (3) lines of text with a maximum of 15 characters per line (including spaces and punctuation).*
- GRANITE SQUARE PAVER - \$4,000**  
*Granite square pavers (2' x 2') will be inscribed individually and inlaid between the granite benches encircling the memorial. Inscriptions will consist of three (3) lines of text with a maximum of 15 characters per line (including spaces and punctuation).*
- MEMORIAL PLAQUE & GRANITE PAVER - \$10,000**  
*The memorial will be bordered by a brick planter along the east side. A bronze plaque will be inscribed with supporter names and displayed on the brick planter. Inscriptions will consist of two (2) lines of text with a maximum of 15 characters per line (including spaces and punctuation). Please note that multiple supporter names will be inscribed on the plaque.*
- MEMORIAL BENCH & GRANITE PAVER - \$20,000**  
*The memorial will be encircled by four granite benches. Supporter names will be inscribed along the edge of each bench. Inscriptions will consist of two (2) lines of text with a maximum of 15 characters per line (including spaces and punctuation).*

### Granite Paver

Granite pavers (5" x 8") will be inscribed individually and inlaid around a Maltese cross on the ground of the memorial. The pavers are limited to three (3) lines of text with a maximum of 15 characters per line. Paver sponsorship is \$550.

### Granite Square Paver

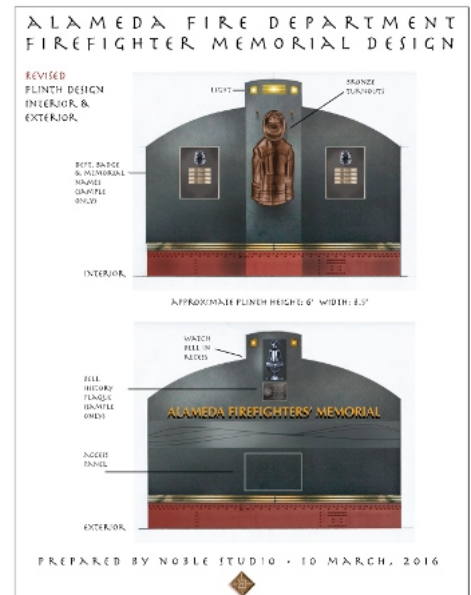
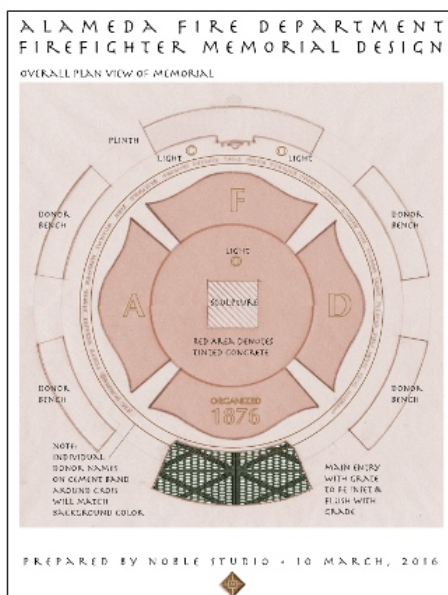
Large granite square pavers (2' x 2') will be inscribed individually and inlaid on the ground between the granite benches encircling the memorial. The square pavers are limited to three (3) lines of text with a maximum of 15 characters per line. Square paver sponsorship is \$4,000.

### Memorial Bench

Four granite benches will encircle the memorial and provide a place for visitors to reflect and honor those who have given their lives in service to our community. Sponsor names will be inscribed along the edge of each bench. Inscriptions are limited to two (2) lines of text with a maximum of 15 characters per line. Bench sponsorship is \$20,000 and will also include a granite paver (5" x 8").

### Memorial Plaque

A bronze plaque will be displayed along a brick planter on the east side of the memorial. The plaque will be inscribed with sponsor names. Inscriptions are limited to two (2) lines of text with a maximum of 15 characters per line. Please note that multiple supporter names will be inscribed on the plaque. Plaque sponsorship is \$10,000 and will also include a granite paver (5" x 8").
