Recommendation: Removal – This tree was determined for removal per the City's <u>Tree removal policy</u>. Section D-All Other Tree Removals. Any resident or property owner can protest this determination in writing: October 30, 2025 – November 20, 2025. Protest procedures are in Section E of the City's <u>Tree Removal Policy</u>.

## Summary:

The Liquidambar tree at 1620 Benton St. is in declining health and causing a public infrastructure and ADA conflict. . A certified arborist has assessed the tree and recommends removal, no treatment is available to resolve the tree health issues that were caused by previous root pruning. Additional root pruning has been identified as the only possible site modification to resolve the infrastructure conflict, it is estimated that additional pruning would damage the tree beyond recovery and destabilize the tree creating a fall hazard.
