The Camphor tree at 214 Beach Rd. is in decline and is causing a public infrastructure and ADA conflict. A certified arborist has assessed the tree to be in decline and recommends removal, no treatment is available to resolve the tree health issues, further modifying the adjacent sidewalk and hardscape to resolve the ADA issue will damage the already dying tree Removal of the tree will restore the adjacent sidewalk to meet ADA requirements. .
