Recommendation: Removal – This tree was recommended for removal per the City's <u>Tree removal policy</u>. Section D-All Other Tree Removals. Any resident or property owner can protest this determination in writing: October 7, 2025 – October 28, 2025. Protest procedures are in Section E of the City's <u>Tree Removal Policy</u>.

Summary:

This tree at 218 Beach Rd. F-1 is causing a public infrastructure and ADA conflict. Removal of the tree will restore the adjacent bike path and sidewalk to meet ADA requirements. A certified arborist has assessed the tree to be in severe decline and recommends removal. Modifying the adjacent sidewalk and hardscape will damage the already dying tree.
