Recommendation: Removal – This tree was recommended for removal per the City's <u>Tree removal policy</u>. Section D-All Other Tree Removals. Any resident or property owner can protest this determination in writing: November 21, 2025 – December 12, 2025. Protest procedures are in Section E of the City's <u>Tree Removal Policy</u>.

Summary:

This tree at 1015 Oak street is causing a persistent public infrastructure and ADA conflict. The adjacent sidewalk and curb were previously modified to accommodate the tree which the tree has now outgrown. Additional root removal and other modifications of the tree were evaluated and are not possible to resolve the conflict. A certified arborist has provided this assessment and determined the tree to be too large for its space and recommends removal. Removal of the tree will restore the adjacent sidewalk to meet ADA requirements.
