Summary:

This tree is in poor health, and there are no practical or reasonable options available to remedy this health issue. Extensive fungal fruiting bodies are present on the trunk and lower limbs. Bark is peeling and decay is present. While the canopy appears to be healthy, this trunk decay is extensive enough that removal is recommended.
