Summary:


This tree at 3252 Fairview Ave. F-1 is causing a public infrastructure and ADA conflict. The tree has outgrown its space and site modifications have been evaluated but the space issue cannot be mitigated by practical and reasonable options, any modifications to the surrounding hardscape would destabilize the tree resulting in failure of the tree. Removal of the tree will restore the adjacent bike path and sidewalk to meet ADA requirements.
