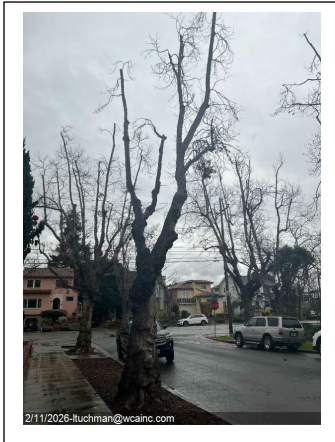
# TREE REMOVAL NOTICE

The Public Works Department has scheduled the removal of this publicly owned tree after May 9, 2026.

This tree is being removed for the following reason: The tree has extensive rot and damage that will eventually cause the tree to die. The tree should be removed consistent with the City of Alameda Tree Removal Policy Section D ( All Other Tree Removal – 3 Weeks Posting)

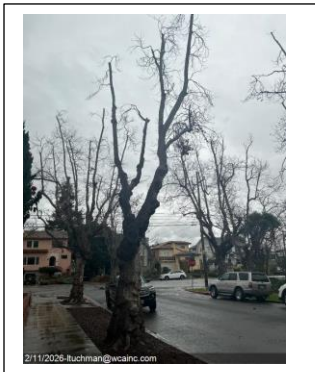
Species: Platanus x hispanica – London Plane Tree

Recommendation: Removal - This tree was determined for removal per the [City's Tree Removal Policy](#). Section D- All Other Tree Removals. Any resident or property owner can protest this determination in writing: April 14, 2026-May 5, 2026. Protest procedures are in Section E of the [City's Tree Removal Policy](#).

Summary:

The tree at 3258 Fernside Boulevard has extensive rot and decay that will ultimately cause the tree to fail. The crown has extensive rot within the branches, and the trunk has extensive rot as well as missing bark, these conditions will eventually cause the tree to die. There are no practical and reasonable options to mitigate the condition therefore tree will eventually die and removal is recommended.
