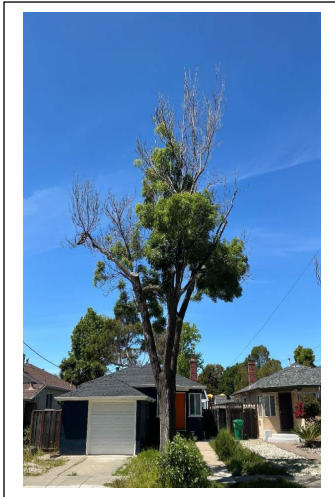
# TREE REMOVAL NOTICE

This tree is being removed for the following reason: The tree has extensive decay and damage that will eventually cause the tree to die. The tree should be removed consistent with the City of Alameda Tree Removal Policy Section D ( All Other Tree Removal – 3 Weeks Posting)

Summary:

The tree at 989 High Street has extensive bark damage and decay within the crown. These are indicators of ongoing decline which will ultimately cause the tree to die. There are no practical and reasonable options to mitigate the decline therefore removal is recommended.
