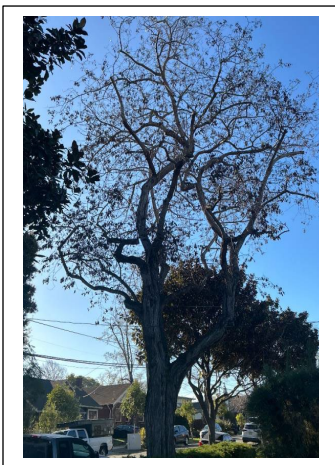
# TREE REMOVAL NOTICE

The Public Works Department has scheduled the removal of this publicly owned tree after June 4, 2026.

This tree is being removed for the following reason: The tree has extensive decay in the trunk causing cracking and separation of large branches, this will eventually cause the tree to die. The tree should be removed consistent with the City of Alameda Tree Removal Policy Section D (All Other Tree Removals – 3 Weeks)

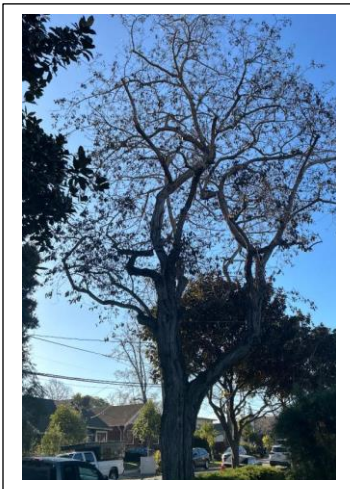

Species: Robinia psuedoacacia – Black Locust

Recommendation: Removal - This tree was determined for removal per the [City's Tree Removal Policy](#). Section D- All Other Tree Removals. Any resident or property owner can protest this determination in writing: May 14, 2026- June 4, 2026. Protest procedures are in Section E of the [City's Tree Removal Policy](#).

Summary: The tree on 1723 8<sup>th</sup> Street has extensive decay in the trunk. The decay is causing cracking and separation of the two large main branches and will likely cause trunk failure. There are no practical and reasonable options to mitigate the condition, therefore removal is recommended.
