This tree is being removed for the following reason:

The tree has undergone Arborist evaluation which concludes tree has major branch and trunk decay, this will eventually cause the tree to die. The tree should be removed consistent with the City of Alameda Tree Removal Policy Section D (All Other Tree Removal – 3 Week Notice).

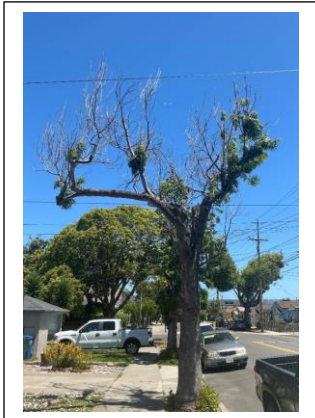
Species: Fraxinus angustifolia 'Raywood' - Raywood Ash Tree
