The Public Works Department has scheduled the removal of this publicly owned tree after July 8, 2026.

This tree is being removed for the following reason: The tree is in conflict with adjacent infrastructure and ADA and should be removed consistent with the City of Alameda Tree Removal Policy Section D (All Other Tree Removal – 3 Weeks Posting)

Species: Cinnamomum camphora – Camphor Tree

Recommendation: This tree was determined for removal per the City's [Tree removal policy](#). Section D-All Other Tree Removals. Any resident or property owner can protest this determination in writing: June 17, 2026 – July 8, 2026. Protest procedures are in Section E of the City's [Tree Removal Policy](#).

Summary: The tree at 3110 Marina Dr. R-3 is causing a public infrastructure and ADA conflict. The tree has outgrown its space, and site modifications have been evaluated but the space issues cannot be mitigated by practical and reasonable options. Any modifications to the tree roots to restore the hardscape would destabilize the tree resulting in failure of the tree. Removal of the tree will restore the adjacent sidewalk and curb and gutter to meet ADA requirements.
