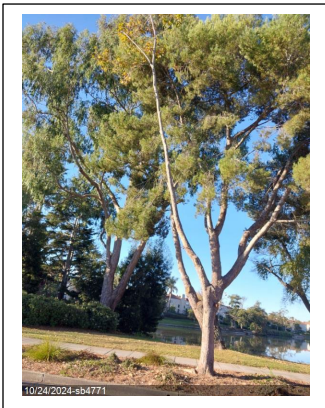
TREE REMOVAL NOTICE

The Public Works Department has scheduled the removal of this publicly owned tree after July 16, 2026.

This tree is being removed for the following reason: The tree has major branch and trunk decay that will eventually cause the tree to die. The tree should be removed consistent with the City of Alameda Tree Removal Policy Section D (All Other Tree Removal – 3 Week Posting).

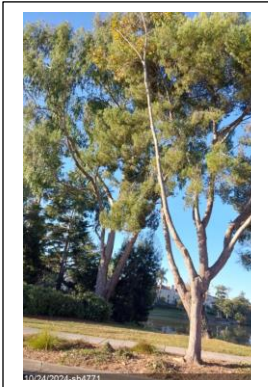

Species: Platanus x. Hispanica- London Plane Tree

Recommendation: Removal - This tree was determined for removal per the [City's Tree Removal Policy](#). Section D- All Other Tree Removals. Any resident or property owner can protest this determination in writing: June 25, 2026 – July 16, 2026. Protest procedures are in Section E of the [City's Tree Removal Policy](#).

Summary: The tree at 130 Basinside Way has extensive decay along major branches as well as significant cracks along the trunk. There are no practical or reasonable options to mitigate these conditions and eventually the tree will die, therefore removal is recommended.
