TREE REMOVAL NOTICE

The Public Works Department has scheduled the removal of this publicly owned tree after July 2, 2026.

This tree is being removed for the following reason:

An Arborist evaluation concludes the tree has major branch and trunk decline. This will eventually cause the tree to die and present risk. The tree should be removed consistent with the City of Alameda Tree Removal Policy Section D (All Other Tree Removal – 3 Week Notice).

Summary:

The tree at 1008 Morton Street is causing a public infrastructure and ADA conflict. The tree is also in declining health and will eventually die. There are no practical or reasonable options to mitigate these conditions. Modifications to the surrounding infrastructure would damage the root system of the tree and progress the decline. Removal of the tree will restore the adjacent curb, gutter and street to meet City standards and ADA requirements
