The Public Works Department has scheduled the removal of this publicly owned tree after October 6, 2026.

This tree is being removed for the following reason: The tree is in conflict with adjacent infrastructure and ADA requirements and should be removed consistent with the City of Alameda Tree Removal Policy Section D (All Other Tree Removal – 3 Weeks Posting)

Summary:

This tree at 1033 Mound Street S-1 is causing a public infrastructure and ADA conflict. The tree has outgrown its space and site modifications have been evaluated but the space issue cannot be mitigated by practical and reasonable options, any modifications to the surrounding hardscape, including root pruning, would destabilize the tree resulting in failure of the tree. Removal of the tree will restore the adjacent sidewalk to meet ADA requirements.
