The Public Works Department has scheduled the removal of this publicly owned tree after August 27, 2026.

This tree is being removed for the following reason: The tree is in conflict with adjacent infrastructure and ADA requirements and should be removed consistent with the City of Alameda Tree Removal Policy Section D (All Other Tree Removal – 3 Weeks Posting)

Recommendation: Removal – This tree was determined for removal per the City's [Tree removal policy](#). Section D-All Other Tree Removals. Any resident or property owner can protest this determination in writing: August 5, 2026 – August 26, 2026. Protest procedures are in Section E of the City's [Tree Removal Policy](#).

Summary:

The tree at 3265 Encinal Avenue is causing a public infrastructure and ADA conflict. Site modifications have been evaluated to resolve the conflict but there are no practical and reasonable options to resolve the conflict. The root pruning necessary to restore the hardscape would negatively impact the tree's structural stability and could lead to tree failure. Removal of the tree will restore the adjacent sidewalk to comply with City standards and ADA requirements.
