DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

FIVE STEPS TO BE READY

Emergency planning does not have to be complicated. Start with these five steps and review them with everyone in your household.

IMPORTANT

Plan to be self-sufficient for at least one week.

START WITH THESE FIVE STEPS

1

GET EMERGENCY ALERTS

Sign up for **AC Alert** and save official information sources.

2

KNOW YOUR ZONE

Look up and save your evacuation zone before an emergency.

3

MAKE A PLAN

Choose contacts, meeting places, routes, and support plans.

4

BUILD A ONE-WEEK KIT

Start with what you have and add essential supplies over time.

5

LEARN LOCAL HAZARDS

Prepare for earthquakes, tsunamis, flooding, heat, outages, and smoke.

- ☐ water – 1 gal per person/day
- ☐ food
- ☐ hand crank radio
- ☐ flashlight
- ☐ first aid and medication
- ☐ batteries and chargers
- ☐ mask
- ☐ tools
- ☐ maps
- ☐ pet supplies
- ☐ duct tape
- ☐ hygiene items
- ☐ personal documents
